ARTICLE REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Total number of pages 4-5. Without numbering.
- 2. File extension *.doc, *.docx.
- 3. Page size A4. Margins: top and bottom 2.0 cm, left 3 cm, right 1.5 cm. Font Times New Roman; tipe size 12 pt, single spacing.
- 4. The title of article is set in capital letters, Times Bold, center alignment, without hyphenation. At one interval from the title is a list of authors (center alignment). The style for the names is surname then initials. The addresses of the authors' affiliations (including e-mail; Times Ital.) follow the list of authors. If the authors are at different addresses, numbered superscripts should be used after each surname to reference an author to his/her address. After one interval the above information is duplicated in English. Further in one interval follows the main text (width alignment, indent 1 cm).
- 5. Figures are inserted into the text. They can be provided as separate files (extension *.jpg, resolution not less than 300 dpi). Captions should be below the figure (Times Normal, center alignment, without hyphenation). Tables should be numbered sequentially throughout the text. Captions should be placed at the top of the table (center alignment; but the table number is right alignment). Formulas created in the formula editor should be numbered. The reference to the formula is given in the text in parentheses.
- 6. The list of references (Times Normal, width alignment, numbered; according to GOST 7.1-2003) follows the main text and has the heading

"References" (Times Bold, center alignment). Reference is given in the text in square brackets.

7. The article file is called the name of the first author. Admission deadline is April 29, 2019.
